

**United Way of Lake County “WinningXTwo” Raffle**  
**-Official Contest Rules-**

1. HOW THE CONTEST WORKS: Raffle tickets can be purchased online at [uwlc.org/winning](http://uwlc.org/winning). Hard copies of actual tickets can also be purchased from an authorized United Way of Lake County representative. If you purchase raffle tickets online your name will automatically be entered into the contest and no physical tickets will be issued. If you make your raffle ticket purchase(s) online, your name will automatically be entered in the contest based on the number of tickets you purchased (For example, if you bought 4 tickets and got 1 free, then your name will be entered into our contest 5 times).

Two (2) winners will be selected. Each winner and their non-profit beneficiaries of choice (those they listed on either the physical raffle ticket or on the online raffle ticket purchase form at the time of raffle ticket purchase) will each win \$1,250. This means there will be a total of four (4) total winners who will each win \$1,250.

2. Non-profit beneficiaries must be non-political entities.
3. If a non-profit beneficiary was not filled in on the raffle ticket form (print or electronic) at time the raffle ticket purchase is made, then United Way of Lake County will serve as the beneficiary.
4. Odds of winning are based on the total number of tickets purchased.
5. Must be 18 years or older at time raffle ticket purchase is made to qualify for entry into the contest.
6. Contest ends March 14, 2019 on or about 12:30 pm. Winner will be selected at United Way of Lake County’s Celebrity Server Fundraiser on March 14, 2019 from 11: 30 am – 1:30 pm at the American-Croatian Lodge. Winners do not need to be present to win. 7. Purchase of WinningXTwo raffle tickets constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Contest Rules.
8. Winners must present a driver’s license and a copy of winning ticket if a hard copy was purchased. If the winning ticket was purchased electronically online, then winners must simply present a driver’s license to claim prize. Winning non-profit beneficiaries must submit proof of current, valid non-profit status.
9. Proceeds from this raffle benefit United Way of Lake County.

10. United Way of Lake County, its employees, agents, representatives, affiliates and their immediate family and household members are not eligible to participate.
